Arrival to Austria and to the event location

All participants are asked to arrive until 13:00 at the Hotel Steinschalerhof on the 30th of September 2013.

From **Vienna International Airport** you will continue travelling to your destination, **Rabenstein/Pielach** in Lower Austria.

Please schedule at least 2-3 hours for your trip from Vienna International Airport to Rabenstein/Pielach. You can go by rental car or public transport.

When you arrive at Vienna International Airport you can go by bus, by City Airport Train (CAT) and by suburban railway to the city and further on **to "Wien Westbahnhof"** which is the train station in Vienna that brings you to Lower Austria.

From "Wien Westbahnhof" take the train to "St. Pölten Hauptbahnhof" and there you have to switch to the train "Mariazellerbahn" (platform 13), with which you can enjoy a nice scenic train ride to the station "Steinschal-Tradigist". The hotel is connected to this train station (you walk in driving direction of the train to the street and then turn right).

From St. Pölten Hauptbahnhof you also can go by taxi to Steinschalerhof (taxi rank is at the rear exit of St. Pölten Hauptbahnhof).
